WILD FLOWERS - A GIFT FROM GAIA



I think one of the most beautiful sights in Spring and Summer is the beautiful wild flowers that pop up all over the place. The daisies, buttercups, dandelions and countless others have a simple beauty which is easy to take for granted. But these flowers are often the first to bloom in the early spring when other more showy blooms are nowhere near ready. As such, they are essential to pollinators. Our native bees, already struggling with disease and toxic chemicals would have to struggle even harder if they didn't have our own native flowers to rely on.

And our flowers are useful. Every part of the dandelion is edible. The roots can be ground up to make a coffee type drink. The leaves can be used in salads. The blossom of the many flowers can also be eaten in salads. Not to mention that they make great offerings. Rather than tying ribbons to trees which if tied too tightly can impede the growth of the tree and if the wrong material is used then they don't biodegrade, I prefer to simply scatter the petals of wild flowers around the base of the tree while saying a prayer of gratitude. And, of course, wild flowers are free. They are not imported from other countries using air miles. They need no toxic chemicals to make them grow.

The thought that a little dandelion seed, light enough to be carried on the wind, can when it connects with the Earth push through a crack in concrete is mind blowing! If that little seed can do that, what can we do if we put our minds to it? Gaia gives us these beautiful flowers as a free gift. They are a symbol of the bounty of the Earth. All of them are different; in colour, shape and size, just like we are. Their diversity is part of their beauty and their strength with different flowers drawing in different pollinators. White flowers often bloom late in the evenings or at night and are usually pollinated by moths. So day or night wild flowers always have something to offer.

LAMMAS TO SAMHAIN ASTROLOGY



And so, the wheel turns to Lammas, and we find ourselves experiencing some of the most seismic astrology of our times as Urania, Mars and the North Node come together in the sign of Taurus, the Abundant Earth Mother on the 1st of August. This triple conjunction amplifies the collective lessons we have been learning around the use of resources and our treatment of our Earth. There can be breakdown and breakthroughs as we continue to liberate ourselves from the old patriarchal systems.

The Aquarius Full Moon on the 12th of August also powerfully activates this alignment, showing us that we can create equality if we come together in community. August is a month of intense Uranian Energy, which can bring many shocks and revelations, yet the Virgo New Moon on the 27th offers us a moment of integration. This Lunation in the sign of the Priestess Healer invites us to spend some time reorganising and realigning as we prepare to enter the darker half of the year once more.

As we descend into Autumn, Mercuria the Messenger begins Her 3rd retrograde journey of the year on the 9th of September. She will be moving between the signs of Libra and Virgo during this period, calling us into ever deeper levels of purification, decluttering and rebalancing. With Mars also entering Her retrograde shadow in Gemini at this time, its important to take note of the themes that are playing out in our lives as we will be revisiting them over the coming six months.


The Pisces Full Moon rises on the 10th of September, reminding us to stay connected to our compassion and intuition amongst all the logical, cerebral energies that are dominating the cosmos at this time. It is time to practice surrender and trust that what is meant for us, will come to us.



Sol moves into Libra on the 23rd of September, as we celebrate Mabon. All is held in a perfect moment equilibrium as we move in the season of the Goddess of the Scales. The Libra New Moon rises on the 25th of September, placing our focus on justice and fairness for all. Sitting in opposition to Jupitera in Aries, this Lunation may also call us into rebalancing our needs with those of other, placing relationship issues under the spotlight.

Mercuria stations direct at 24 degrees Virgo on the 3rd of October, whilst in opposition to Nebulous Neptunia in Pisces. What was hidden under a shroud of illusion is now revealed. The Aries Full Moon reaches its peak on the 9th of October, sitting next to Chiron and opposite Venus and Sol in Libra. This Full Moon rises as Plutonia, the Dark Mother stations direct, offering us a period of alchemical release and catharsis. Sol enters the sign of the Scorpioness on the 23rd of October, with a New Moon Eclipse on the 25th leading us into a profoundly transformative Samhain Season.

THE NINE SACRED TREES OF AVALON AND BRIDANNIA – ASH, BEECH, AND APPLE WOMAN

Continuing our spiralling journey, meeting with the trees of the wheel of Avalon and Bridannia. we find ourselves at Lammas in the Southwest. Here stands Ash woman, with the great golden Mother Goddess Ker, she who brings us the first harvest. All that was seeded in the darkness and quickened at Imbolc ripens and begins to be manifested in this world. This is the birthing of our dreams - Cornucopia, Goddess of fruitfulness, abundance, and joy. Here we also honour Morgen Mystress Glitonea in all her golden glory.

In Norse mythology Odin hung on the Ash tree for nine days and nights to receive the wisdom of the runes. One night when I sat with Ash Woman, Freya whispered to me that it was in fact she who had taught this wisdom to Odin – but that is a story for another time.

Ash is the tree of Inspiration (full of spirit) and Ecstasy (outside of the self) and Initiation (beginning, entry, and rebirth). Sit with Ash Woman this season. Listen to the wisdom that she may share with you. Allow yourself to be inspired. Open you heart to the experience of ecstasy. Surrender to the initiation of Ash woman.

You may like to make your own set of symbols for oracling, or scrying received directly from Ash woman. These may become your gateway tool for the revelation of yoniversal wisdom.

Arriving now at the Autumn Equinox in the West we meet with Beech Woman who stands with Banbha, ancient goddess from the times before the great floods that shaped Bridget's Isles. Here we also meet with Morgen Moronoe, mature in her wisdom and knowing, respected for her grounded gracious presence. Sit beneath the wide spread of a beech tree. She will protect you, giving shelter and sanctuary. Make some beads from beech and wear for protection and comfort. They will help you maintain the integrity of your auric space from intrusion and dis-ease.

Now that we have completed our journey around the rim of the wheel we step into the centre. Here we meet with Apple woman who stands with Nolava, goddess of the mystical otherworld sacred Isle of Avalon, Bridannia, tutelary goddess of Brigit's Isles – her name a combination of maiden goddess Brid and ancient one Annia, and Morgen Ia Fey, mystress



of magic and enchantment. The apple is a potent magical symbol in mythology, faerie tale, folklore, and literature ancient and modern: apple for teacher, an apple a day keeps the doctor away – health and wellbeing; forbidden fruit in the garden of Eden, poison in Snow White - both stories of initiation; silver apples of the moon, golden apples of the sun - WB Yeats 'The song of wandering Aengus', a tale of divine inspiration and ecstatic longing. Plant an apple tree. Let this tree be your connection to Avalon. Eat the fruits every autumn and press apple juice to use in ceremony. Make a wand from apple wood. Apple Woman is the Mystrix of deep magic and enchantment.
