SACRED CRAFTING FOR LAMMAS

During the season of Lammas, sacred crafting offers us the opportunity to connect to the season, express our gratitude and explore our creativity. Crafting can have the added benefit of improving our wellbeing and relaxation.

As we continue our new cycle, we explore sacred craft projects connected to each of the seasons and Goddesses around the Avalonian wheel. These crafts can also be seasonal offerings for your altar and will help you connect to the energy of each season.

Whilst you are crafting have in mind that there is a deep connection between our creative activities and our spirituality. As we create and make something either on our own or with others we heal, integrate and transform our bodies, mind and soul. As we craft, we express ourselves in a grounded and tangible way. We may find the activity meditative and find it fosters mindfulness as we create, finding a deeper sense of purpose and connection with ourselves.

Crafting is also a way of caring for ourselves as we connect with our inner world.

Here are some suggestions for this month:

Spend some time outdoors, taking in the sights, smells and sounds of summer. What does Lammas mean to you? Collect any found items that call to you and take home for your altar.

Share the abundance of this time of year with others, perhaps in a crafting circle, or sharing food with others. Perhaps bake bread or something else to share with others and put your intentions for this time of year into whatever you bake.

Celebrate the first harvest and perhaps create a simple ritual to honour the and where you live.

Seasonal Lammas Door Charm by Amber Skyes

You will need:

Seasonal flowers and seeds,

Small bundles of barley

Twigs, crafting wire and scissors

Creating your Lammas Door Charm:

Take the twigs and wrap with the wire into a circle.

Add small bundles of barley to the twig circle and secure with wire.

Snip off the long ends of barley. When the circle is completed add seed heads and/or flowers to celebrate the season. Continue adding until you have finished. Give gratitude for the abundance of nature's gifts.
